

Christmas Mystery 2008

from Merete Veian :: part 2

Here is the second part of the Mystery, - and we will be sewing again, of course!

This is what you will need to cut and sew 1 of block B and 1 of block C.

If you would like to cut and sew 4 blocks of each, as will be needed to get 4 tablemats, do so.

Bring out the 3" light colored background strip, - 3" x ca 17".

You will also need the brown strip, - ¾" x ca 12".

From the 3" light strip, cut for block B and block C:

2 rectangles 3" x 1,5"

1 rectangle 3" x 2,5"

2 squares 3" x 3"

1 rectangle 3" x 3,5"

Block B

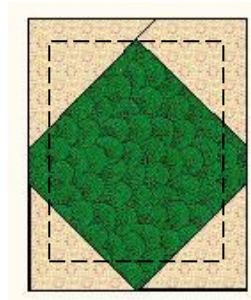
1 light background rectangle 3" x 1,5"

2 light background squares 3" x 3"

2 of block A

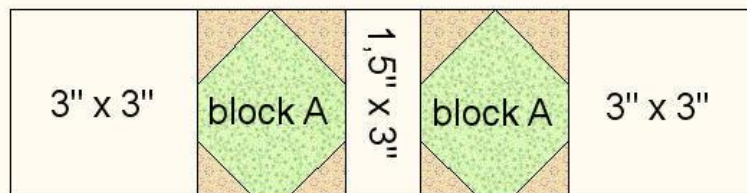
Look at the figure at the right, - note where the top is.

of block A



Place the 3" x 1,5" rectangle in the middle of 2 of block A and with one of each 3" x 3" green square at the sides as shown.

Sew the pieces together.



Block C

1 light background rectangle 3" x 1,5"

1 light background rectangle 3" x 2,5"

1 light background rectangle 3" x 3,5"

2 of block A

Place the 3" x 1,5" rectangle in the middle of 2 of block and sew them together.

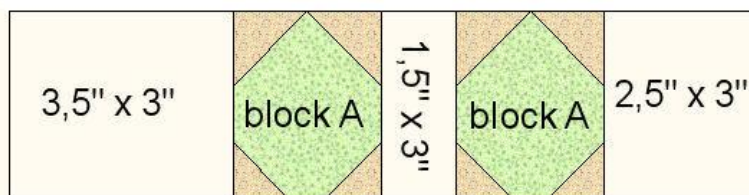
Look at the figure and note where the top of block A goes.

Place 1 light background rectangle 3" x 3,5" to the left and 1 light background rectangle 3" x 2,5" to the right.

Sew the pieces together.

Block D

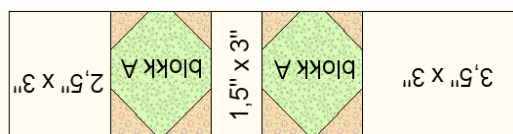
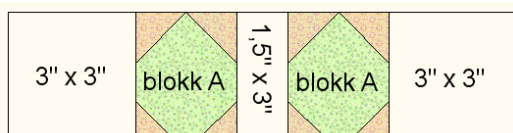
Bring out the $\frac{3}{4}$ " brow strip.

Cut it to be $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 10,5".

Place the brown strip between block B and block C.

Note that all of block A have the tops pointing **outward**, away from the strip.

Sew block B and block C together with the strip in the middle.



4 tablemats

Use the rest of block A from part 1, - 12 blocks.

Cut and sew more of block B and block C together, - 3 of each.

Cut and sew block B and block C together with the brown strips for 3 more blocks, - and you have a total of 4 tablemat blocks now.
