Wall hanging

Finished size: 18 ½" x 18 ½"

### Fabric requirements

You will need a variety of scraps to make this wall hanging:  
Using the picture as guidance, select

Main block     Dark blue - background main block.  
                    A variety of green and blue squares,  
                    cutting size 3 ½" x 3 ½ "

Scraps for the appliqué motifs

- Orange, Blue, Pink, Black, White, Brown, Off-White

Border 1        Blue - 2 strips 1" cutting size  
Border         Grey - 2 strips 13 ½" x 3"  
                    Blue - 2 strips 13 ½" x 3"  
                    Dark blue - 4 corner squares 3" x 3"

Binding        Pink - 2 strips from whole width of fabric  
                    - cut 2 ¼ wide for double binding

Thin batting:  22" x 22"

Backing        22" x 22"

### Blocks you need

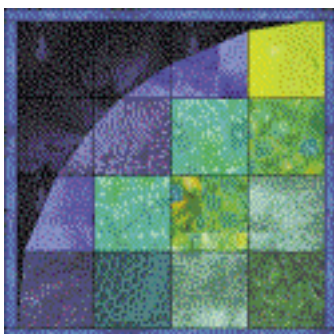
Main block - 12" x 12" + s.a.

Appliqué motifs - part 2

- 2 boys

- 2 girls

- Stars



Center block  
finished size 12" x 12" + first border

Measurement  
test  
1 x 1 inch

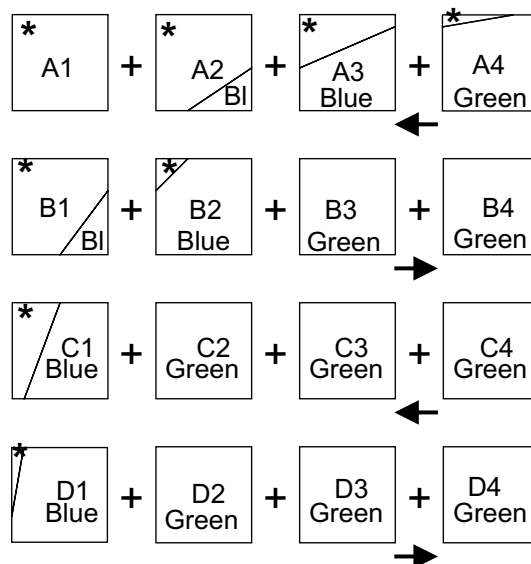
**Main block - finished size 12" x 12"**

1. Enlarge the pattern by 200 % to 12" x 12"  
 make 2 copies, keep one as guide.
  2. Cut the pattern apart and use paper foundation piecing for the following parts:
    - A2, A3 and A4
    - B1 and B2
    - C1 and D1
- Remember to add seam allowances to all of these patches.

Cut the required number of blue and green squares - follow picture for color guidance - cutting size 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

Join the paperpieced patches and the other squares into 4 rows as shown in diagram, press seams as indicated by arrows.

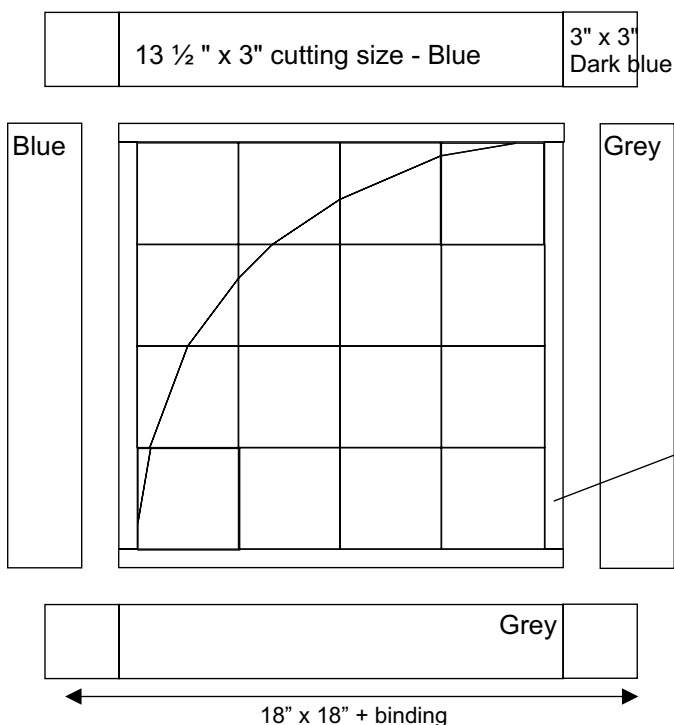
**Adding the borders:**

**Border 1**

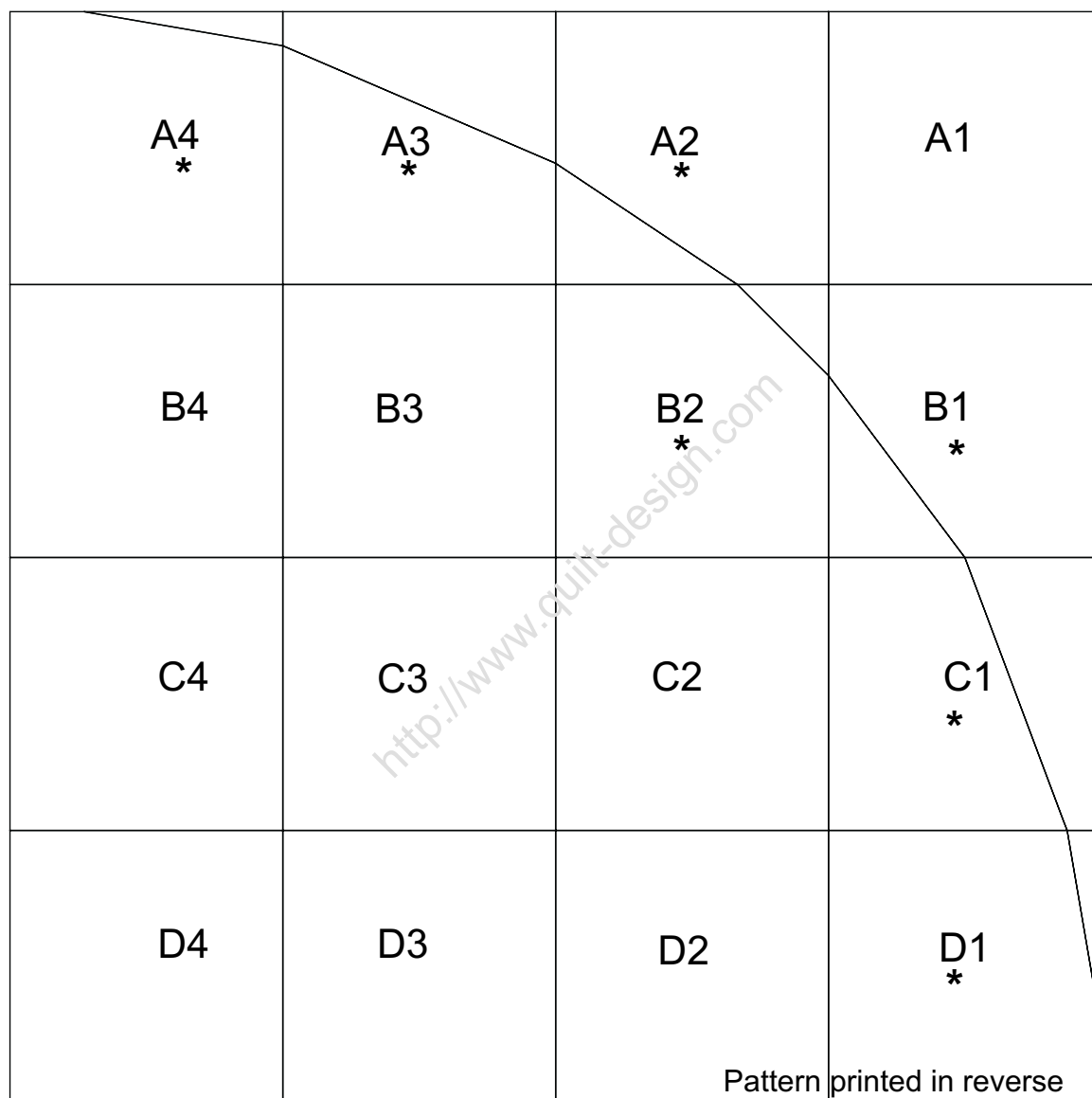
Stitch one blue strip to the right and left side of center block.  
 Stitch to the top and bottom, press seams toward borderstrip.

**Border 2:**

Stitch one blue strip to the right and and one grey strip to the left side of the center block - see diagram.  
 Add one dark blue square - cutting size 3" x 3" to each end of the remaining border strips, press seams toward borders,  
 stitch the blue strip to top and the grey to the bottom.  
 Press seams toward border.

Enlarge this block by 200 % to 12" x 12",  
size of each patch - 3" x 3" finished size.

follow directions on page 2 for piecing the block.
